THIS WEEK | This weekend we celebrate Holy Rood's Feast of Title. On Friday 24 September is the feast of Our Lady of Walsingham: Evensong and Benediction at 5.30pm; Sung Mass of the feast (transferred) Saturday 25, 5.00pm.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION | There will be an obligatory but brief meeting for all parents/guardians of First Holy Communion children on **Sunday 3 October 2021, 3.30pm at Holy Rood.**

ST JOHN HENRY NEWMAN AND ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT | His feast day is on Saturday 9 October this year (see below). Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at Holy Rood all day (9.30am to 4.30pm), as we did before the feast of the Assumption in August. There will be a sign-up sheet in church. It would be good if we could make this extended Adoration a regular thing in due course—perhaps something like the first Saturday of the month. Please think and pray about this.

MISSIO | The Pope's charity for world mission has representatives all over the world, and asks for your help. Here, we usually do this with the famous red boxes, in which you can put your spare change, and then collect it up. If you have a red box, please bring it to church for counting. If you would like a red box of your very own, our local rep Barbara can be contacted through the parish office. See www.missio.org.uk for more.

FOR YOUR DIARY | This weekend we keep Holy Rood's feast of title in that church: there are certain feasts which may be kept on a Sunday near their proper day for the benefit of the faithful, and this is one of them. On the same basis we will observe Our Lady of the Rosary—this time across the whole parish—on the first weekend in October (2nd and 3rd). The following Saturday, 9 October, is the feast of St John Henry Newman: we will have Adoration all day, and at 5.00pm a Sung Mass with the Newman Consort singing, at which the guest preacher will be Fr Paul Martin, Director of the St Barnabas Society. Details of the other Newman-related events in Oxford, including the Newman Night Walk, will be advertised here nearer the time.

SUNDAYS | The Sunday and Holy Day Mass Obligation remains suspended until at least 28 November 2021. The worship of God is our duty and our joy, and so we must always take time for him on Sundays and Holy Days. Our best way of doing this is by participating in Holy Mass. If we can't do this, we should pray and read the scriptures.

REGULATIONS | **Please read carefully: Correct as of 1 September 2021.** **BOOKING FOR MASS** Booking is not required. **COMING INTO CHURCH** The track-and-trace facility continues to operate, so we invite you to sign in or use the QR code. Hand sanitizer continues to be available: please use it. **MASKS AND DISTANCING** Masks are no longer required, but may be recommended. Please leave space between you and others, and be aware of others' needs. **SINGING** Masses with congregational singing are clearly indicated on the front page of the Newsletter by an asterisk*. **HOLY COMMUNION** From the Bishops' Conference Document: "Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and the ministers will continue to sanitise their hands beforehand and wear a face covering whilst distributing. Communion is recommended to be distributed in the hand but those who wish to receive on the tongue may do so. There should be care on the part of the minister to avoid physical contact with the hand or the tongue of the communicant when distributing Holy Communion. In the event of contamination the minister should sanitize their hands before further distribution." **CLEANING** We are no longer require to ask you to clean where you've been sitting. You can if you wish: materials remain available. Thanks for your patience and help.

CAFOD | Cafod's annual Autumn Fast Day is on Friday 1 October this year. They are also organising help for the people of Afghanistan: CAFOD started working in that country in the late 1980s and a core part of its work has been to support Afghan organisations committed to improving the lives of vulnerable and marginalised people, supporting them to earn a living.
