ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION | My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

LET US PRAY | Among the sick and those in need, we pray for Rhidian, Bryan, and all who have asked for our prayers. Please pray also for Bernie Cowley, convalescing after illness. This week, we pray in particular for all who live and work within the boundaries of our parish, for departed worshippers in our churches, for our parish's founders, benefactors, and past clergy. We ask the prayers of Our Lady of the Rosary for all we do.

THIS WEEK | We are celebrating our parish's patronal festival this weekend. If you can, I do encourage you to do something nice after Mass to celebrate. Do also take a card with the Angelus on it, to assist you in your prayers. There will be a second collection for Cafod at all masses this weekend, following last week's appeals and "family fast day" this past Friday. Saturday 9 October is the feast of St John Henry Newman. The night before, Friday 8, Oxford's annual Newman Night walk departs from the Oratory (St Aloysius) at 7.00pm, making the following stations (which anyone not wishing to follow Blessed Dominic's journey in full can join): 9pm Candlelight Procession from Rose Hill to Bl. Dominic Barberi Church, Littlemore; 9:30pm Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament; 9:50pm Benediction and Procession to The College Library and Chapel, Littlemore, with Archbishop Cushley of St Andrews and Edinburgh. On the day itself, there is Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at Holy Rood between 10am and 4.30pm, and at 5.00pm a Sung Mass with the Newman Consort singing, at which our guest preacher will be Fr Paul Martin, Director of the St Barnabas Society.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION | There will be an obligatory but brief meeting for all parents/guardians of First Holy Communion children this **Sunday 3 October 2021, 3.30pm at Holy Rood.**

MISSIO | The Pope's charity for world mission has representatives all over the world, and asks for your help. Here, we usually do this with the famous red boxes, in which you can put your spare change, and then collect it up. If you have a red box, please bring it to church for counting. SUNDAYS | The Sunday and Holy Day Mass Obligation remains suspended until at least 28 November 2021. The worship of God is our duty and our joy, and so we must always take time for him on Sundays and Holy Days. Our best way of doing this is by participating in Holy Mass. If we can't do this, we should pray and read the scriptures.

REGULATIONS | **Please read carefully: Correct as of 1 October 2021.** **BOOKING FOR MASS** Booking is not required. **COMING INTO CHURCH** The track-and-trace facility continues to operate, so we invite you to sign in or use the QR code. Hand sanitizer continues to be available: please use it. **MASKS AND DISTANCING** Masks are no longer required, but may be recommended. Please leave space between you and others, and be aware of others' needs. **SINGING** Masses and other services with congregational singing are clearly indicated on the front page of the Newsletter by an asterisk*. **HOLY COMMUNION** From the Bishops' Conference Document: "Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and the ministers will continue to sanitise their hands beforehand and wear a face covering whilst distributing. Communion is recommended to be distributed in the hand but those who wish to receive on the tongue may do so. There should be care on the part of the minister to avoid physical contact with the hand or the tongue of the communicant when distributing Holy Communion. In the event of contamination the minister should sanitize their hands before further distribution." **CLEANING** We are no longer require to ask you to clean where you've been sitting. You can if you wish: materials remain available. Thanks for your patience and help. **NB (1/10/21)** Students are returning to our universities: we will need a week or two to see whether that makes an appreciable difference to our situation and to the diocesan or local health advice we're given.

CAFOD | Second collection for Cafod this weekend (2/3 October). Cafod are also organising help for the people of Afghanistan: CAFOD started working in that country in the late 1980s and a core part of its work has been to support Afghan organisations committed to improving the lives of vulnerable and marginalised people, supporting them to earn a living.
