**LET US PRAY** | We pray for those whose needs are known to us, and those who have no one else to pray for them. In particular this month we pray for those who have died recently, and those whose anniversaries fall about this time.

**THIS WEEK** | Second Collection at all Masses weekend of 6/7 November for our partner-diocese of Bamenda, Cameroon. Next weekend is Remembrance Sunday, and the 11.15am Mass at Holy Rood is a requiem for all the dead of war. We pray the Act of Remembrance together at 10.58am for Armistice Day. The music is the *Requiem* by Gabriel Fauré.

**NOVEMBER: MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS** | For a Mass for the repose of the soul of an individual/family members to be offered on a specific day/time, please use the normal white Mass intention envelopes. To put a number of names on the “November List”, use the purple envelopes. Please don’t use a purple envelope if you want a named intention on a particular day. Envelopes go in the collection boxes in church. *For this month, a bit of information each week about what we do for the faithful departed.* **Masses of the Day, Masses of the Dead** | Say you have a departed loved one for whom you’d like Mass to be offered. A significant date (eg anniversary of death) is 9 November. You might ask if you could have Mass that day offered for his/her soul. 9 Nov is the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. So the proper Mass for that day, with its readings and prayers, would be offered for the intention of your loved one. On days that aren’t feasts (this week, 8 and 13 Nov), you could instead ask to have a Requiem Mass offered (which, NB, is not the same as a funeral Mass). This is a Mass at which all the texts and prayers, and sometimes the readings, are specifically ‘themed’ around praying for the dead. Now, a Mass of the Day and a Mass of the dead are equally as effectual for the deceased, but they can help the living in different ways. A cake with exactly the same ingredients can be a birthday cake, a Christmas cake, a wedding cake, a Sunday afternoon tea cake, because though the cake-ness is the same, what you do with it (decorations, candles, little sugarcraft nativity figures) helps set the mood or tone of the occasion. Similarly, the prayers at Masses for the dead can help us, if we need it, to pray (for the dead, for ourselves, for reconciliation, for a good death, etc). Sometimes it’s right and fitting, other times not, but if you are interested, do please ask.

**NEWMAN SOCIETY: OXFORD UNIVERSITY CATHOLIC SOCIETY ANNUAL LECTURE AND MASS** | On Saturday 13 November the NS:OUC holds its annual St Thomas More Lecture at the Exam. Schools. This year’s lecturer is His Eminence George Cardinal Pell. This is preceded by Mass at **12.30pm** which this year, at the Society’s request and with Bishop Philip’s blessing, is to be celebrated at Holy Rood: the Cardinal will celebrate (according to the *Divine Worship* missal) and preach; music by Imogen Holst and William Byrd, sung by the Newman Consort. Admission to the lecture is strictly by ticket only (details at [newmansociety.co.uk](http://newmansociety.co.uk)), but all are very welcome to the Mass. The Holy Rood visiting priests’ book reveals that not-then-Cardinal Pell last celebrated Mass here in April 1969—he is a few lines down from Herbert McCabe OP, up from Bishop Derek Worlock, and over the page from Louis Bouyer.

**OTHER SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION Confirmation Classes** for Confirmation in early summer 2022. Please get in touch with the office to register for these, and please also speak to Fr Daniel. **Adults:** For baptism, reception into the full communion of the Catholic Church, or confirmation for those baptised Catholic as children but not confirmed, please speak to Fr Daniel and also get in touch with the office. **NB** Now that restrictions are so light, all appointments for meetings about babies’ baptisms, and weddings (whether here or elsewhere) are to be made in person after Mass on Sundays.

**SUNDAYS** | The Sunday and Holy Day Mass Obligation remains suspended until at least 28 November 2021. The worship of God is our duty and our joy, and so we must always take time for him on Sundays and Holy Days.

**REGULATIONS** | **BOOKING FOR MASS** Not required. **COMING INTO CHURCH** Please sign in or use the QR code for track and trace. Hand sanitizer continues to be available: please use it. **MASKS AND DISTANCING** Masks are no longer required: this is now up to you. Please leave, and be aware of others’ needs. Try to talk outside rather than inside if possible. **SINGING** Congregational singing is indicated on the front of the Newsletter by an asterisk\*. **HOLY COMMUNION** From the Bishops’ Conference Document: “Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and the ministers will continue to sanitise their hands beforehand and wear a face covering whilst distributing. Communion is recommended to be distributed in the hand but those who wish to receive on the tongue may do so.” Thanks for your patience and help.
